Performances: Saturday, March 10 at 3pm and 7pm at Poway Center for the Performing Arts

The Details: You **must pre-register** for the audition by submitting your registration form at www.powayonstage.org. Or print, complete and submit your form at the audition. The audition will be held on Monday, March 5 at 4pm **SHARP** at the Poway Center for the Performing Arts. There is parking immediately behind the Theater on Titan Way. If you need a paper registration form mailed to you, please e-mail sokeefe@powayonstage.org.

There are roles for students in Kindergarten through 12th grade. Approximately 50-60 local students will be cast to appear in the show with the MCT Tour Actor/Director. **There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play.** Students wishing to audition must arrive by the scheduled starting time and stay for the entire two-hour session. The first rehearsal begins approximately 15-30 minutes after the audition.

This is a group audition - **no advance preparation is necessary**, but a smile ☺ never hurts.

The Schedule: Those auditioning must be available for ALL rehearsals for their role and for both performances on Saturday. You must have a clear schedule Monday through Friday 4:00-8:30pm and all day Saturday. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the audition. Cast members scheduled for the full 4½ hours of rehearsal will be asked to bring a sack dinner or snack. Typically, the youngest students are not scheduled for the 6:30-8:30 rehearsals.

Performance Tickets: Tickets can be purchased online at www.powayonstage.org. Seating for these shows is General Admission. Cost is \$20 for Adults and \$9 for Youth (18 & under).
